Healing week 2020

05-02-2020

Healing week started with the Morning Prayer. A special prayer prepared by Atul from Lab department with full of bible quotes was prayed along with Morning Prayer. We prayed for all patients, their families and care takers, staff, doctors and all paramedical staff, students and their tutors.

At 10am Dr Sudhir Srivastava, Medical superintendent of Fatima Hospital addressed the audience in the OPD. He said about the importance of healing week and Pope John Paul 2nd started the world day of the sick on 11th February in the year 1992 to pray for the sick and suffering all over the world. This is the 28th world day of the sick. The theme for this year is "Come to me all you who labour and are burdened and I will give you rest (Mt 11/28). He said Fatima Hospital will conduct several awareness programme, every day at 10am and will be continued for one week. On 6th Blood sugar test will be free for all and on 11th General Physicians Consultation will be free. He advised patients to take benefit of this.



Dr Tauseef Ahmad, our pediatrician gave awareness about breast feeding. He said touch is very important for secretion of milk. Mother has to feed baby by taking the baby in their hands. Breast milk has a good role for brain development. Always remember that, baby has not been given both breasts to suck milk partially at a time. This will lead baby to suck the superficial milk only and the deep milk will be left over. So, allow baby to take milk completely from one breast, then next time from the other breast. Deep milk is very good for brain development. Breast feeding is beneficial for both mother and baby, because we can eliminate some type of cancers. Six month is the right period for breast feeding.



06-02-2020

The day started with a special prayer for patients and families, nurses and para medical staff, all employees of hospital and students by Sr Anupa Kujur. She quoted bible words of compassion and healing and prayed for all of them. She, in her prayer mentioned that this year WHO has designated the year to pray for nurses and midwives.

At 9 am free blood sugar check up camp started and finished by 2pm. About 150 patients had check up.



At 10am Dr Gaurav Gupta Dentist and Bracelets specialist gave talk to patients regarding Dental Hygiene, disorders of teeth and gum problems, bad odors from mouth, importance of cleaning the tongue, care of teeth of babies, importance of brushing the teeth at night etc, etc. He had interaction with Patients and they cleared their doubts.



07-02-2020

Along with Morning Prayer there was a special prayer (prepared by Miss Lilly Philip) for patients all over the world, especially for Corona Virus affected people of China and for patients with long term illness. It was a prayer that touches the heart. She prayed for all care takers and doctors and students.

At 10am Mrs Richa Khare, Dietician of our hospital took class on special diet regime for those who suffer from Diabetes, Hypertension, Thyroid disorders pregnancy etc.etc. There was an interaction period and they cleared their enormous doubts. Since the OPD is getting late we concluded it by 10.50am



At 1.30pm there was “Skill development programme” for all the incharge and sub charge staff. 31 staff including sisters attended the programme. It was conducted by Nestle Company.....He Talked about communication and soft skills. He has done a Google rating about our hospital and it was 3.8. It is a good result. And also explained on proactive and reactive behavior and the need of proactive behavior. And also explained the difference between group work and Team work. When he explained on “Time management”, he said about the importance of prioritizing the work. Eg. Urgent and important must be done first.



08-02-2020

The Morning Prayer started with a hymn to Mother Mary followed by reading passages of healing from the Bible. A special prayer prepared by Mrs Nelly covered all the sick in the world, all care givers and students, sick people's families etc. We prayed for the Delhi election too that people may select a just and empathetic leader who listens and loves people and understands their problems.

At 10am Dr Sudhir Srivastava Medical superintendent of our hospital welcomed Dr Ranjana (Vaccine In charge) from Civil Hospital. She gave awareness on Immunization in the OPD Hall. Dr Mrithunjay Pandey Our Senior Pediatrician also told practical points regarding immunization. There was interaction section. Many including doctors asked questions and cleared their doubts. Dr Sudhir, our medical superintendent concluded the programme with "Thanks giving" to both the resource person at 10.50am. 10-02-2020

And also said the pregnant women should consume 150mg Iodine daily

Today being the world sick day, Consultation fees for Medical checkup for the physician's patient was free. Patients benefitted from it.

When food was served to the husband, he had complaint for the quality of food; but in place of food, phone accessories was served, unknowingly started to take it with spoon to eat. All laughed a lot by seeing it. There was a good crowd to see this play.



At 2.30pm we watched Tele video Class by Dr Anna George Quality Manager of Rajagiri hospital regarding “Quality Accreditation in Health care - The why and how of it”. The session was for 35mts. Sisters, Nurses, quality manager and Lab staff attended the programme.



At 6pm there was special talk and healing prayer by Rev. Fr. Lawrence in the OPD Hall. Staff and patients attended the prayer.



13-02-2020

A Medical Camp was arranged at Bahrouli village in Kursi Road. Sr Lalitha took charge of it. Babblu, Students, Staff and Doctors Saket and Vivek Rai went from Fatima Hospital. 165 patients benefitted from it. 172 patients attended the clinic.

A Rosary procession was conducted at 6pm in the hospital on the occasion of the feast of "Our Lady of Lourdes". Sisters, Staff and students participated in it.
